# Unit 1 Creative Expression Activity Plan

## Activity Title:

Bilingual Puppet Show: Expressing Feelings in Spanish

## Objective:

In this engaging activity, students will learn to express feelings in Spanish using simple phrases such as "¿Cómo estás?" (How are you?). Through arts and crafts, they will create emotion puppets and participate in a bilingual puppet show. This activity will help students reinforce their Spanish vocabulary for expressing emotions, encourage creative thinking, and promote teamwork as they practice asking and responding to "¿Cómo estás?" in Spanish.

## Learning Outcomes:

## Instructions:

1. Watch the Video.
2. Create Your Puppets.
  - Use two brown bags to make emotion puppets. Cut shapes from construction paper for eyes and expressions, glue them on, and color in details.
3. Practice the Show.
  - Pair up and ask each other "¿Cómo estás?"
  - Respond with the feeling your puppet represents in Spanish (e.g., "Estoy feliz").
  - Act out a short scene using both English and Spanish.
4. Perform:
  - Present your bilingual puppet show to the class. Each show should include two feelings and the "¿Cómo estás?" dialogue in Spanish.
