



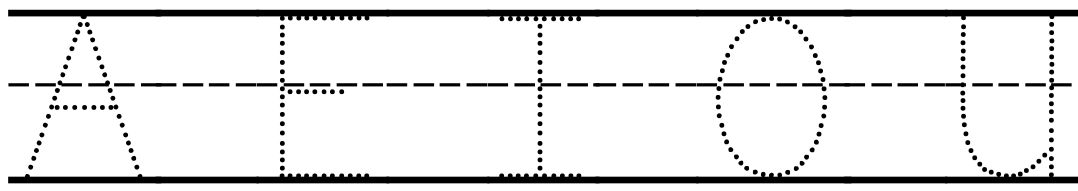

Spanish Vowels

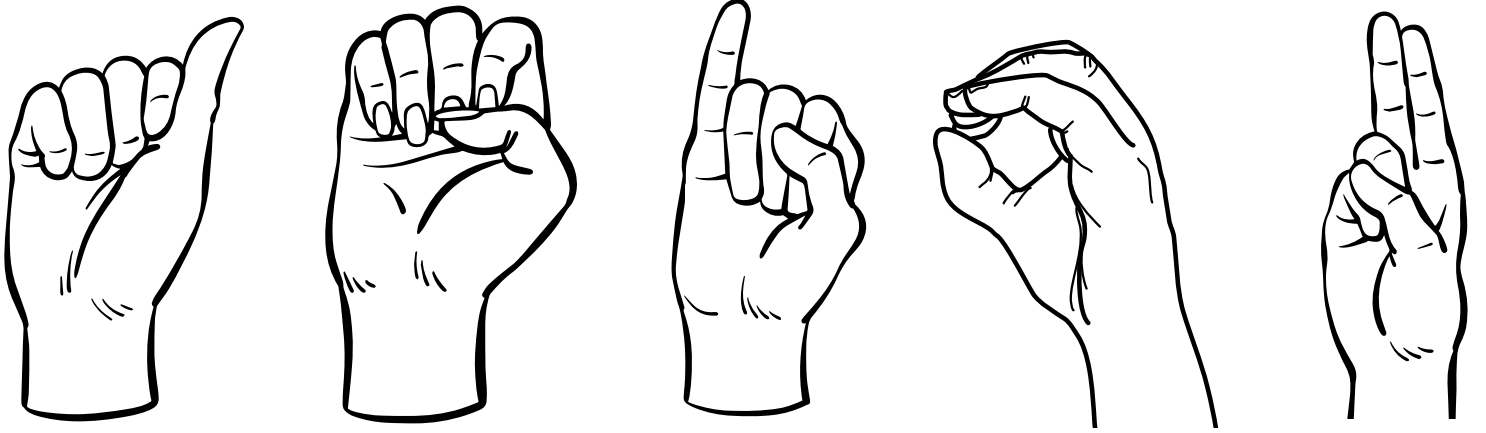
Did you know? In Spanish, every word has at least one vowel - they're the heart of the language!

Did you know? Both English and Spanish have 5 written vowels (A, E, I, O, U), but while these vowels can make up to 20 different sounds in English, in Spanish it's simple: 5 letters, 5 sounds!
